

Level 1 - Building confidence and knowledge

Level 1 is an introductory level course for those wishing to enhance their play or build their basic officiating skills. Candidates are expected to download and familiarise themselves with the latest set of singles rules available from the WSO website, which may be used during the test.

There is no minimum age to take this certified test. The online test allows a candidate to have 5 wrong answers throughout the 25 questions, if more than 5 incorrect answers are given, then the candidate must start again with a freshly generated set of questions.

Upon successful completion of the test, candidates will be sent a Level 1 accreditation certificate and be entitled to wear the WSO Level 1 shirt logo on any apparel. Level 1 accreditation is valid for 2 years, after which the official must repeat the modular training and online test. The Level 1 registration fee of \$15 is annual.

Certification of an official is the responsibility of WSO. Details will be housed on the WSO website and be shared with the appropriate member nation. Each member nation will encourage prospective officials to complete the WSO Level requirements.

Requirements:

1. Must complete the online Level 1 modular coursework
2. Must hold a current WSO Level 0 certificate
